Living in Quito: Quito is an extremely attractive place to live. It nestles in a stunning Andean valley surrounded by volcanic peaks. It has the best-preserved historic center in Latin America and has been designated a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Quito also has cosmopolitan modern areas with first-rate restaurants, bars and clubs. It is a relatively safe city to live in and its climate is sometimes described as “the eternal spring”. Salaries in this part of the world might not seem that attractive compared to the US, but the cost of living is extremely low.

Overview of the Position: The primary responsibility of the Director of College Counseling is to assist students and their families with the university search, application, and matriculation processes.

Main Duties and Responsibilities:

- Update and deliver annually college counseling and vocational-orientation curriculum for a diverse population of roughly 200 students across grades 9-12
- Through regular communications and meetings, assist students and their families with the selection, application, and matriculation processes for national and international universities including essay writing and editing as well as support for financial aid and scholarship applications
- Provide direct support to students searching and applying for summer and/or exchange programs, and planning gap years
- Train and guide grade 10-12 students in effective use of Maia Learning, our college and career readiness platform
- Directly supervise and evaluate the performance of the College Counseling Assistant
- Manage departmental budget

- Serve on Secondary Leadership Team with Secondary Director, Director of Psychology, and IB MYP and DP Curriculum Coordinators
- Work closely with the DP Coordinator and Psychology Department to help students align course selection, career goals and interests, and university entry requirements
- Establish, develop, and maintain relationships with university admissions representatives in Ecuador and around the world
- Write letters of recommendation for current and former students
- Edit and review English translations of teacher letters of recommendation from Spanish
- Inform students about standardized testing dates and assist with registration process (ACT, SAT, TOEFL, DELF, IELTS) and administer PSAT
- Work closely with the Quito counseling network (international schools, embassies, EducationUSA Office, and Fulbright Commission) to coordinate 300+ university visits and events through the year
- Record and track information relating to admission, scholarship, and financial aid decisions and student matriculation data

Essential Skills and Requirements:

- Bachelor's degree and 2 years experience working with students in college and career counseling
- Excellent English oral and written communication skills
- Bilingual Spanish/English or willingness to learn Spanish to an advanced level

Preferred:

- Master's degree and/or certification in College and Career Counseling
- Knowledge and experience of a wide range of tertiary education options worldwide
- Knowledge and experience of middle and high school IB programs (MYP and DP)
